Leadline classes are for children 10 years and under. Suitable attire for the type of class must be worn by both competitor and handler and an ESNZ approved safety helmet for all children under 10 years is compulsory. Competitors in the Leadline Classes are not eligible to compete in any other ridden classes. Horses may compete elsewhere with a different rider.

Horse and Rider combinations in the Walk & Jog classes may not compete in any other ridden classes, however a Horse may compete with a different rider, and a Rider with a different horse. If numbers permit, this class may be split.

## SHOW TERMS & CONDITIONS

Entries Close: 9pm, Friday 15<sup>th</sup> Feb, 2019

**No Late Entries:** Any amendments to entries after closing date may incur a 50% penalty fee per class. Additional classes for horses already entered may be accepted up to 1 hour prior to the start of each days' competition at entry fee plus 50% per class.

- Ribbons for all classes – Trophies where applicable.
- Prize money paid to 3<sup>rd</sup> place as above with six or more horses in a class.
- All Prize Monies will be paid by cheque within 14 days of completion of the Show.
- The show committee reserves the right to jackpot entry fees less 50% where there are less than 6 entries in a class.
- The show committee reserves the right to substitute sponsored goods for prize money to at least the same value.

### Terms & Conditions:

- All Competitors must be financial members of ApHANZ Inc. A Non-member may show a horse In-Hand/Halter if the Horse's Owner is a financial member of ApHANZ and is present on the grounds. A Non-member may ride on behalf of a Member if that Member is present on the grounds and the Rider has obtained a Day Membership Card prior to the start of the day's competition. Day Membership Cards are available from the Show Secretary.
- All Competitors in the Non-Studbook, Sportaloosa and Grade Appaloosa Competition must obtain a Day Membership Card with their Entry Forms unless they are already financial members of ApHANZ.
- Horses registered in the ApHANZ Main Studbook are not eligible for entry into the Non-Studbook, Sportaloosa and Grade Appaloosa Competition and vice versa.
- This is a closed Breed Show. All Studbook entrants 2 years and over must be adult registered, Foals and yearlings progeny recorded. Halter classes will be run under ApHANZ breed rules. Western Performance will be run under NZWRF rules. English Performance classes will be run under the guidance of ESNZ rules. English Points received are for ApHANZ only. False manes, tails and any artificial colouring will not be allowed at any time throughout this show. Manes may be plaited for English day and may be banded for halter and western performance days.
- This Show will award double points in all points approved classes. Non-Studbook, Sportaloosa and Grade Horses points are awarded for Show High Point awards only.
- All ApHANZ Non-Studbook or Sportaloosa registered horses are eligible for Entry. Grade Appaloosa refers to any other Appaloosa horse 14hh and over, who displays prominent Appaloosa characteristics (i.e. easily recognized as appaloosa from 4m away, Pintaloosas and Paint horses are not eligible).
- Walk and Jog classes are to be ridden to the age of the horse ie senior horse in curb and one handed. Entrants that ride in any Walk and Jog class are not eligible to enter ANY open classes. A horse can compete in Walk & Jog and Open classes as long as it is with different riders.
- Leadline classes are for riders 10 years and under, an ESNZ approved safety helmet must be worn by all Leadline Riders.
- Riders must wear ESNZ tagged approved helmets for all speed and English riding events.
- Dogs must be contained or on a lead at all times.
- All horses must be in their allocated yards/stables at night.
- All stallions 2 years and over must be identified with a Red S Stallion Tag on their halter or bridle at all times. All Stallions 2yrs and older and must be stabled when unsupervised. Youth may not ride or be in control of a stallion at any time during the show.
- Mares with foal at foot must be stabled.
- Portable, tape or electric fence pens are not permitted – there are plenty of yards provided.
- Horses tied to trucks or floats must be supervised at all times. Floats must be attached to tow vehicle.
- Yards and Stables must be left clean.
- The ApHANZ Inc. and co-sponsoring organisations, if any, will not be responsible for any accident that may occur to or be caused by any horse at the show, or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or in any way damaged.
- Horses with NZWRF numbers must use them. Any Horses without NZWRF numbers will be allocated an ApHANZ number for the show. Numbers will be supplied in the competitor's packs, available on arrival from the Show Secretary Office.
- Application for refund must be submitted within seven days of the conclusion of show, and must be accompanied with a Vet or Doctors Certificate that has been issued within those same seven days. All refunds less 20% admin fee.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to alter or amend this schedule, merge or split classes or cancel the show if there are insufficient entries. There must be a minimum of 25 horses entered at closing date for this show to be held.
